Air Cargo Air cargo liability laws are broken into international and domestic categories Depending on the air carrier used, the carrier's specific tariff classification for a shipment sets the limits of liability Thus, limitations may be seven days or less, and the financial liability may be less than \$50 per package

Pursuant to its authority, TSA is currently publishing an air cargo security final rule (FR) that will significantly enhance air cargo security requirements The FR significantly enhances air cargo security while preserving, to the fullest extent possible, the efficiency and timeliness of air cargo operations
